Amy Henke, PsyD, is a licensed clinical psychologist at Children's Hospital New Orleans. She earned her doctoral degree in clinical psychology from Nova Southeastern University with a specialization in child and family psychology. She completed her internship at Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center in infant and child psychology, followed by post-doctoral fellowship at Children's Hospital New Orleans in pediatric health psychology.

Dr. Henke is also the Director of the Balance Collective, a first-of-its-kind care team helping families and children dealing with eating disorders. With more than 10 years of experience, Dr. Henke values the opportunity to provide specialty psychological services and improve access to psychological care for children and families across the gulf coast.
