Professor Emeritus and Former Neonatology Fellow Receive US Patent as Part of Research Team

A research team at LSUHSC led by Sunyoung Kim, PhD, Professor of

Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, received a patent for a noninvasive diagnostic test for necrotizing enterocolitis (NEC) called NECDetect. Pediatrics Professor Emeritus **Dr. Duna Penn** and Neonatology Fellowship Graduate **Dr. Zeromeh Gerber** are listed as co-inventors. The noninvasive NECDetect biomarker panel performed on stool samples identifies 93% true positives and 95% true negatives in diagnosing the disease. Congratulations to them and the entire Neonatology Division who were a part of this research!

Attention Current and Future Primary Care Physicians: LA State Loan Repayment Program

Primary care physicians who work 32 hours in an outpatient setting per week in an area that is underserved (New Orleans) or rural area are eligible for the State Loan Repayment Program (SLRP). They provide \$90,000 over three years with the option for an additional \$24,000 spread over two additional years.

State Loan Repayment Program will be open for application from January 3, 2023 - March 31, 2023.
