

### **Foundation Expenditure Policy for Holiday Parties**

On behalf of The Foundation Board of Directors the following guidance is being offered when considering what fund to use, and if alcohol should be permitted during you upcoming holiday parties:

Holiday parties are events supported by your Foundation accounts, in most cases using your department's discretionary fund is the best option. However, for those hosting Holiday parties where students and/or residents are to be invited, then using Endowed Funds which support the education of residents and students is encouraged and the best fund to use.

Alcohol: If the presences of others (spouses, significant others) attending holiday events add to the benefit of LSUHSC, then alcohol can be

permitted. Additionally, those holiday parties which include students, residents and interns alcohol can be permitted. Alcohol will be limited to 2 drinks per person and all attendees are expected to drink responsibly and to remember they are ambassadors of LSUHSC, the University and the Foundation.
