

Apply for the Pediatric Subspecialty Loan Repayment Program

After over a decade of advocacy from the American Academy of Pediatrics, <u>applications are now open</u> for the first awards from the Pediatric Subspecialty Loan Repayment Program. Pediatric medical subspecialists and pediatric surgical specialists are eligible to apply for \$100,000 in loan repayment. The deadline to apply is July 20.

Awardees must commit to serving an underserved area for three years. The program is available for both fellowship trainees and those who have completed fellowship. The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) will fund 150 awardees this year.

National HIV Testing Day - June 27

National HIV Testing Day is recognized on June 27, and this year's theme is "HIV Testing is Self-care." Getting tested for HIV and knowing one's status can help people stay healthy. The American Academy of Pediatrics currently recommends routine HIV screenings in teens, however, according to the 2021 YRBS, 87.5% of high school students in Louisiana surveyed had never received an HIV test. Support our young people in having the information they need to care for themselves on National HIV Testing Day and every day!
