Together, they will provide valuable support to Amanda in fulfilling the various responsibilities with this position.



Apply for the Pediatric Subspecialty Loan Repayment Program

After over a decade of advocacy from the American Academy of Pediatrics, <u>applications are now open</u> for the first awards from the Pediatric Subspecialty Loan Repayment Program. Pediatric medical subspecialists and pediatric surgical specialists are eligible to apply for \$100,000 in loan repayment. The deadline to apply is this Thursday, July 20.

Awardees must commit to serving an underserved area for three years. The program is available for both fellowship trainees and those who have completed fellowship. The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) will fund 150 awardees this year.

NIH-funded ComPASS Program Research Opportunities

The NIH Common Fund has initiated an exciting program to address health disparities associated with adverse social determinants of health. The new program is centered on supporting community community-led health



equity structural intervention (CHESI) projects. Full details on the program can be found here: <u>ComPASS program</u>

Opportunities for academic investigators to collaborate and support community organizations in their execution of structural interventions have become available. See this notice of intent for more information. The NIDDK, encourages investigators and teams focusing on research within their own mission to consider applying. There is an estimated application due date of October 23.

On 7/13/23, the FDA approved Opill, a progestin only pill, for over the counter use. Opill is a daily contraceptive pill that will soon be available without a prescription necessary, without any age restrictions for those seeking contraceptive care."
