Dear All,

I am pleased to report that, despite the challenging economy, your support and commitment to the School of Medicine and the Alumni Association has been clearly demonstrated in the last year. Contributions totaling \$858,920.58 have been made and distributed according to your instructions, primarily to support professorships and chairs and to the Russell C. Klein Center for Advanced Practice and the Isidore Cohn, Jr., Learning Center. The Alumni Office has been actively involved in support of several medical student projects, including the Student-Run Homeless Clinics and Camp Tiger.

The School of Medicine has had a recent site visit from the Liason Committee on Medical Education, the accrediting agency for medical schools. Preliminary reports are very positive, although the final report is not available at the time of this printing.

In many ways, the School of Medicine is stronger than ever although constant budget threats remain. Faculty recruitment has been very successful, medical school applications are as strong as ever, and faculty morale is excellent as evidenced by a recent faculty satisfaction survey.

Reunion weekend will be June 11 and 12, 2010, and will honor classes of '45, '46, '47, '48, '50, '55, '60, '65, '70, '75, '80, '85, '90, '95 and '00. The Committee of 100 banquet on June 10, 2010, will celebrate the dedication of the Warren Summer Professorship in Pulmonary Medicine. Appointment

Dr. Richard S. Vander Heide was appointed Jack Perry Strong Professor of Pathology and Head of Pathology in 2009. In October 2009, he was also appointed to a 6-year term as chartered member of NIH/NHLBI Myocardial Ischemia and Metabolism Study Section effective October 2009. Dr. Vander Heide was awarded R21 from NHLBI entitled "New Methods to deliver therapeutic drugs in myocardial ischemia/reperfusion injury," award effective 2/1/10-1/31/12.

Grants

Researchers from the Neuroscience Center of Excellence have attracted three major grants recently from the National Institutes of Health and the Alzheimer's Association. Dr. Nicolas G. Bazan, Professor and Director of the Neuroscience Center of Excellence, received \$3,458,219 in from NIH for his project "Mechanism of Action of Omega-3 Fatty Acids in Brain Injury," Dr. Carmen Canavier, Professor, received \$1,907,879 in funding from NIH for her project "CRCNS: Analysis of synchronization in hybrid neural circuits," and Dr. Walter Lukiw, Associate Professor, received \$200,000 in funding from the Alzheimer's Association for his project "Micro RNA Mediated Neurotropic and synaptic networks in Alzheimer's disease."

Jim Hill, MD, Professor of Ophthalmology, Neuroscience, Pharmacology, & Microbiology and Director of Pharmacology & Infectious Disease was awarded a four-year competing renewal of his NIH grant titled, "Ocular HSV-1 Latency Reactivation and Recurrent Disease." The amount of the current award is \$2,088,477. This will be the 25th year that this award has been at the School of Medicine at the LSUHSC. This grant was also a continuation of one that was initially awarded in 1978 when Dr. Hill was a Professor in the School of Medicine at the Medical College of Georgia, and has been continuous for 32 years. This grant focuses on the molecular biology and the chemotherapy of ocular herpes. Specifically these studies are related to a human gene apolipoprotein E (ApoE). Our ApoE mimetic peptide (patent pending) has

shown to have antiviral and anti-inflammatory activity.

Dr. Jay Kolls, Professor and Chairman of Genetics at the LSU Health Sciences Center New Orleans School of Medicine, has been awarded a \$2.1 million grant over five years by the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute of the National Institutes of Health to further his work on a discovery that plays a critical role in the body's defense against pneumonia.

Dr. Youming Lu, Professor at the Neuroscience Center of Excellence, and his colleagues published in the January issue of the very prestigious journal *Cell* on their discoveries about novel synaptic signaling, entitled "DAPK1 Interaction with NMDA Receptor NR2B Subunits Mediates Brain Damage in Stroke."

Nolan, MD, MBA, and associates had the lead article of *Obstetrics and Gynecology* on Universal Cystoscopy, with Editorial, Jan 2009, as follows: Ibeanu O, Chesson RC, Echols K, Nieves, M, Busangu F, Nolan TE. The Department of Otolaryngology faculty collectively produced over 50 peer-review articles in the scientific literature for 2009.

Paul J. Azar, Jr. ('70), Founder of the Azar Eye Clinic in Lafayette, LA, is the 2009 recipient of the Lafayette Civic Cup. Sponsored by *The Daily Advertiser*, the prestigious annual award has honored some of the city's most influential leaders, starting with Maurice Heymann in 1933. Azar has also treated countless patients free of charge over the course of his 35-year medical career. He fondly recalled performing one complimentary eye surgery for a woman from Honduras many years ago, and following up with annual free checkups.

Dr. Azar has also served his country as a member of the Louisiana National Guard, and was brigade surgeon of the 256th Infantry Brigade when it was called to active duty during Operation Desert Storm. He retired in 2001 with the rank of colonel.

His medical and military experience was tested in the fall of 2005, when hurricanes Katrina and Rita struck the Gulf Coast. As medical director of the Cajundome, he quickly organized physicians with the Lafayette Parish Medical Society in setting up a medical clinic following the storm. Dr. Azar spent days and nights dispensing insulin and blood pressure control medicine to busloads of evacuees, many of them without medication and in need of treatment for pre-existing conditions. The clinic operated for more than 61 days, providing 5,000 free office visits to the evacuees who sheltered there.

Azar also started an ophthalmology program at University Medical Center for indigent patients, donating much of the funding for the clinic's expenses. Resident physicians who were previously trained at Charity Hospital in New Orleans before Hurricane Katrina are now being trained by Dr. Azar and his team at UMC in Lafayette. Dr. Azar was an Alumnus of the Year, elected in 2009.

In Memoriam

Sam F. Hartman (‘41) died at his residence in Beaumont, TX, at the age of 92, on May 17, 2009. Dr. Hartman and his identical twin brother, **Lee Edward Hartman** (‘41), were graduates of the Isidore Newman School in New Orleans, and Louisiana State University, where both were members of Huey Long’s beloved LSU Tigers Marching Band. They both earned their MD degrees from LSU Medical School in New Orleans. During World War II, Dr. Hartman served as a Flight Surgeon assigned to the 8th Air Force’s 96th Bomb Group from 1942-1945. His citations include The Air Medal, Europe-Africa-Middle East Campaign ribbon with six battle stars, and the Presidential Unit Citation with oak leaf cluster. In 1951, he moved from Lake Charles, LA, to Beaumont, TX, where his brother had an established medical practice. There he completed 40 years of general medicine practice before his retirement in 1991.



John Fisher (‘48) died at his home in Dallas, TX, on August 14, 2009, at the age of 84. A graduate of LSUSM in 1948, Dr. Fisher set up medical practice in Dallas in 1954 after serving in the U.S. Air Force. He started his own practice in 1966 and retired in 1993. Dr. Fisher loved to travel in Italy, where he practiced fluent Italian, and he loved opera, especially Giuseppe Verdi’s *Aida*. His real passion, however, was bridge. A Grand Life Master, he won eight North American championships in a long bridge career that included the McKenney Trophy in 1972 for winning the most masterpoints that year.



John Bickers, MD, long-time faculty member, died in January 2010. Joining LSU Medical Center in 1961, Dr. Bickers founded the hematology and oncology section of the Department of Medicine and served as its director for 30 years. He was a key figure in the opening of the leukemia unit at Charity Hospital and was its medical director for 20 years. Dr. Bickers retired from working full time in 1998, and from part-time work in 2005.
