A. Personal Statement

A key goal of the proposed project is Cancer Care Delivery Research. As a nurse and nursing Administrator for over 30 years, I have extensive experience with care delivery. I have not only worked as a staff nurse, I have been a Divisional Director over nursing in various milieus - Respiratory Care, post op Surgical Services, as well as Community Health and Elderly Services. I have also been a Divisional Director over Ancillary Services which has provided a dimension of experience further across the care continuum of support services. For the last 3 ½ - 4 years I have been involved with the Cancer Program of Mary Bird Perkins-Our Lady of the Lake. My first duties included acting as an Interim Service Line administrator over the program which gave me a holistic view of all services. I also worked with physicians and the Multidisciplinary Teams as these were developed with our opportunities as part of the National Cancer Institute Community Cancer Centers Program grant (NCCCP). In December of 2011 I assumed full responsibility for the Multidisciplinary Teams (MDCs) and for Patient Navigations. These teams are physician led with a strong support team base of nursing, social work, clinical research, as well as marketing and community outreach staff. We have 4 multidisciplinary teams - colorectal, lung, head and neck, and skin and soft tissue. Our physician staff are requesting additional MDCs in urology and blood cancers which I will initiate in 2014. I provide oversight and development of these teams and maintain the focus on best practice, patient outcomes, improved patient outcomes, and process improvement for the delivery care and for the care team. I also oversee patient navigation for each disease site which matches the multidisciplinary teams. We have increased our service to patients from approximately 25% of analytical cases for the specific disease sites to over 65% for all the named disease site teams.
