**A. Personal Statement**

I have been involved in tumor registry for over 20 years. I have both regional tumor registry experience as well as Commission on Cancer (CoC) hospital based tumor registry experience. I have been involved in many aspects of tumor registry, including: medical record review, abstracting, and rapid case ascertainment by way of pathology screening. Through partnership with LTR, I have participated in several cancer research studies that primarily focus on patterns of care and quality of life. In addition, as an NCCCP site, I actively participated in two patient-reported outcomes studies. I am the current Director of the Baton Rouge Regional Tumor Registry, which includes 11 parishes around the Baton Rouge area. In addition, my responsibilities include oversight of the hospital based tumor registry of Mary Bird Perkins and OLOL, both of which are accredited by the American College of Surgeons (ACoS) Commission on Cancer (CoC) Approvals Program. I oversee a team of eight cancer registrars, four of which are Certified Tumor Registrars and two which will sit for the exam in March 2014. I am committed to ensuring that registry data contains complete treatment information as well as accuracy of coding and staging elements. I will work in collaboration with other community sites to provide detailed and accurate cancer registry data to support CCDR activities.
