

CHNOLA EPIC Med Staff Update:

Hydrocodone/Acetaminophen Liquid is going to change to only being ordered in mg or mg/kg of hydrocodone. The ability to order in mL is being removed due to an issue in Epic which results in the medication being displayed improperly creating a patient safety issue.

Starting next week a new Mass Transfusion Protocol order set will be added. There will be two choices, less than 30 kg and more than 30 kg. The new order set contains all of the needed lab and blood orders. I have attached a tip sheet on the new order set.

On April 9th, the hospital is going to move to only using Humulin Insulin

products. The orders will be adjusted according and should be easier in not having to worry about which brand to use.

One of the upcoming upgrades coming later this year is moving to a new prescription printing method which will allow prescriptions to print on regular paper with a printed watermark. The advantages are no one will need to find prescription paper and this may be used for controlled substances as well.
