#### **URGENT NOTICE**

to all Providers, Staff, Residents, and Students

LCMC Health, in partnership with LSU and Tulane Student Affairs, have decided that, **effective immediately**, **LSU and Tulane Medical students should not** knowingly participate in the triage, workup or care of any known or suspected cases of COVID-19 at any of the LCMC hospitals: University Medical Center, Touro, West Jefferson, NOEH and Children's Hospital.

If any medical student becomes exposed to known or suspected case of COVID-19 – they are to follow the following protocol:

- 1. Apply surgical mask, report to the ED for evaluation and treatment
- ED charge nurse will notify Infection Control or On-Call Infectious Disease provider for confirmation of source's positive diagnosis of COVID-19.
- 3. Infection Control will notify Employee Health of confirmed COVID-19 cases and list of exposed HCP.
- 4. Exposed HCP will complete COVID-19 Risk Assessment Form (attached) and send to Employee Health.
- 5. Employee Health Services will review assessment form with Infectious Disease Medical Director for guidance.
- 6. Inform their medical school Student Affairs Dean

If any medical student has concern or wants to discuss individual issues – they are instructed to contact their Student Affairs Deans.


