New Faculty:

We welcomed two new Neonatologists to the department on July 1. Anne Nuttli Martin, MD and Anne Tufton, MD are the division's two most recent fellowship graduates.



Anne Nuttli Martin, MD is now Assistant Professor of Clinical Pediatrics. She received her medical degree from LSUHSC-NO in 2016. She completed her Pediatrics Residency in 2019 and Neonatology Fellowship in 2022, both within our LSUHSC Department of Pediatrics. During fellowship, Dr. Martin took part in several quality improvement projects including developing a respiratory care algorithm for premature infants and co-developing a patent ductus arteriosus algorithm for premature infants. As

a New Orleans native known through much of her training as Dr. Nuttli, Annie was married in October 2021. Fellowship Program Director Dr. Dana Rivera commented about Dr. Martin, "Annie's calm demeanor and intuitive clinical skills instill confidence and trust from her colleagues and patients' families. She's gentle, calm, and courageous at the bedside, and the neonatologist you want at your baby's bedside." Along with other division

members, Dr. Martin will be working in NICUs at Children's Hospital, Touro Infirmary, East Jefferson General Hospital, Tulane Lakeside Hospital, North Oaks Medical Center, Lakeview Regional, and Slidell Memorial Hospital.



Anne Tufton, MD joins the department as Assistant Professor of Clinical Pediatrics. She received her medical degree from the University of Queensland School of Medicine in 2016 and completed her Pediatrics Residency in 2019 and Neonatology Fellowship in 2022, both within our LSUHSC Department of Pediatrics. During fellowship, Dr. Tufton was recognized for her research work in identifying a novel biomarker for necrotizing enterocolitis, including being twice honored as outstanding fellow

presenter at LSUHSC Pediatrics Research Day. Also a native New Orleanian, Dr. Tufton's outside interests range from pickleball to Formula 1 racing. Division Head Dr. Brian Barkemeyer stated, "Anne genuinely cares for her patients in a manner that's obvious to those around her. She brings a passion and resilience to her work that's refreshing, making it enjoyable to work with her." Dr. Tufton will work at Children's Hospital, Touro Infirmary, East Jefferson General Hospital, and Tulane Lakeside Hospital.
