Dr. Shubho Sarkar to Lead American Academy of Pediatrics Quality Improvement Initiative

A multidisciplinary team led by Dr. Shubho Sarkar from the Division of Pediatric Hospital Medicine was recently selected to join the American Academy of Pediatrics Value in Inpatient Pediatrics Network, Better Antibiotic Selections in Children (BASiC) National Collaborative. The project launches this fall, and in conjunction with 130 other Children's Hospitals across the country, the Children's Hospital team will be providing and analyzing data on antimicrobial use for the conditions of Pneumonia, UTIs and Skin and Soft Tissue infections in order to develop best



practices for antibiotic use. Other members of the multidisciplinary team include: Greg Cook, PharmD (CHNOLA), Dr. Jay Hescock (LSU Pediatrics), Dr. Silio (Tulane University), Dr. Callie Roth (LSU Pediatric Hospital Medicine Fellow), Dr. Katie Procarione (LSU Resident), Dr. Mac (CHNOLA) and Dr. Leron Finger (CHNOLA).
