<u>Dr. Vanessa de la Cruz</u> (Community and Population Medicine) and Dr. Virginia Saussy (Emergency Medicine) hosted a filled-to-capacity Louisiana Bridge Symposium at the ULL LITE Center in Lafayette on 12/2/25. The symposium provided education and capacity building for hundreds of clinicians and administrators from around Louisiana about processes and structures to improve access and quality of care - including buprenorphine and naloxone for Opioid Use Disorder - through timely, evidence-based care models in the emergency department, inpatient, and outpatient settings. They were joined later at the Bridge Symposium by <u>Dr. Bridgette Egan</u> (Emergency Medicine) who was highlighted as an early Bridge Champion nationally who advocated for evidence-based initiation of buprenorphine and inhand distribution of naloxone from the emergency department.







<u>Dr. R. Brooks Robey</u> (Nephrology) presented "Diuretic Boot Camp: A Systematic Pharmacologic Approach to Optimizing Diuresis in Heart Failure and Kidney Disease," in Primary Care VA-ECHO on Thursday, August 28, 2025. This session was attended by 184 learners from VA sites across the nation. The feedback received from participants was excellent.





This week the Infectious Disease Center HIV Outpatient Program (HOP) was highlighted in the UMC Mission Monday! First established in 1987, HOP provides primary care, subspecialty care, and social services for people with HIV. The University Medical Center commemorated World AIDS Day and NOLA HIV Awareness Week with a variety of educational events held throughout the week.
