Dr. Vijay Nijjar (Pulmonary & Critical Care) and Dr. Giulia Monticone were recently awarded a New Investigator Award from the Louisiana Cancer Research Center. The award carries a grant for a pilot study investigating T-cell exhaustion and senescence in early-stage non-small cell lung cancer. The study will build off Dr. Monticone's previous work on molecular mechanisms of tumor immune evasion by combining it with advanced diagnostics of early-stage tumors by Dr. Nijjar.

Dr. Shelby MacRae (Pulmonary/Critical Care) was recently featured on a podcast produced by the Bronchiectasis & NTM Association focused on helping patients navigate their first bronchiectasis and nontuberculous mycobacteria (NTM) center appointment.
