

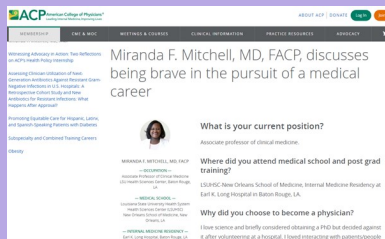
DOM NEWS BLAST

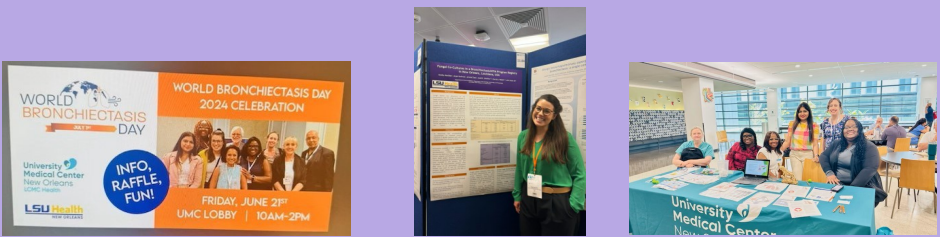
