The **Southern Society for Clinical Investigation** meeting was held last weekend and the Department of Medicine was well represented.

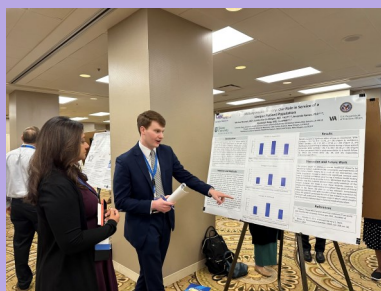
