

The Pediatric Hematology and Oncology Fellowship Program is proud to recognize their fellows for their outstanding scholarly work presented at recent meetings.



Evaluating The Phoenix Sepsis Score as a Predictor of In-Hospital Mortality In Pediatric Hematopoietic Cell Transportation.



Several of the Hematology/Oncology Fellows had their work recognized at the American Society of Pediatric Hematology and Oncology (ASPHO) meeting.





Dr. W. Christopher Golden is an Associate Professor of Pediatrics at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. Dr. Golden received his undergraduate degree in zoology from Duke University. He subsequently completed all of his medical training (medical degree, Pediatrics residency and Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine fellowship) at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. Currently, he is the Director of the Pediatrics Core Clerkship in the School of Medicine and the Medical Director of the Newborn Nursery at Johns Hopkins Hospital. Nationally, Dr. Golden is on the Editorial Advisory Board of *The Journal of*

Pediatrics and Contemporary Pediatrics. He also served as Co-Leader of the Core Clerkship Collaborative of the Council on Medical Student Education in Pediatrics (COMSEP), the premier national organization for design, development, and formal academic study of methods in pediatric education in medical schools.

Dr. Golden also is the Chair (2023-2025) of the Pediatric Section of the National Medical Association (NMA), the largest and oldest organization representing African American physicians (and their patients) in the United States. Objectives: At the conclusion of this activity, participants should be able to:

- Identify the unique features and traits of the current medical student
- Discuss the changing landscape of medical education
- Appraise potential mechanisms for reframing (pediatric) medical student education
