## Innovating Access & Autonomy: The Role of DPC in Modern Pediatric Practice

Christina Piron, MD, is a boardcertified general pediatrician and the owner and founder of MamaDoc NJ, a concierge-style pediatric practice in New Jersey. She completed her pediatric residency at Tulane-Ochsner in

2014, followed by a year as chief resident. Dr. Piron moved to New Jersey with her family in 2020 and launched her current practice in March 2024.

Objectives: At the conclusion of this activity, participants should be able to:

- Describe key challenges within traditional insurance-based pediatric care that are contributing to the growing interest in Direct Primary Care (DPC) models and other nontraditional models of care among both physicians and patients.
- Understand the principles, structure, and variations of DPC and concierge models, and how they differ from traditional care delivery.
- Evaluate how DPC and concierge models may impact physician well-being, patient care, and healthcare accessparticularly in relation to equity and disparities among diverse populations.
- Explore future opportunities to evolve both insurance-based and DPC care models to improve access, equity, and outcomes in pediatric healthcare.
