**Margot Anderson, MD**, is Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at Tulane University School of Medicine. She is board-certified in Pediatric Infectious Diseases, Pediatric Hospital Medicine, and General Pediatrics.

Dr. Anderson earned her medical degree from the University of Connecticut School of Medicine and completed a residency in Pediatrics at the Maine Medical Center in Portland, Maine. She furthered her training with a Fellowship of Pediatric Infectious Diseases at Tulane University. Dr. Anderson spent time practicing abroad in Laos, Eritrea, and Malawi. In 2015, she returned to New Orleans and joined the Tulane University Department of Pediatrics faculty.

Dr. Anderson practices at Children's Hospital New Orleans with both the Pediatric Infectious Disease and Inpatient Pediatrics teams.
