**Kimberly J. Reidy, MD**, is Chief, Division of Pediatric Nephrology and Associate Professor at Children's Hospital at Montefiore (CHAM) and Montefiore Einstein. After earning her Bachelor of Arts in chemistry at Princeton University, Dr. Reidy earned her medical degree from Albert Einstein

College of Medicine. She completed her Pediatric internship and residency at Children's Hospital of New York, New York-Presbyterian. Dr. Reidy then pursued a three-year NIH T32 supported fellowship in Pediatric Nephrology at CHAM.

Dr. Reidy's clinical research focuses on children with glomerular and chronic kidney disease, including NIH funded Nephrotic Syndrome Study Network (NEPTUNE) and Cure Glomerulonephropathy (CureGN) studies of children with nephrotic syndrome.

Dr. Reidy is board-certified in pediatrics and pediatric nephrology. She currently serves on the Executive Committee of the Section of Nephrology for the AAP. From 2016 through 2021, she has been listed among Castle Connolly Top Doctors: New York Metro Area. In 2021, she was elected to membership in the Leo M. Davidoff Society, recognizing her long-term commitment to excellence in teaching medical students.

**Objectives:** At the conclusion of this activity, participants should be able to:

1. Recognize evolving understanding of genetic and immune related factors contributing to childhood onset nephrotic syndrome.
2. Understand risk factors for worse outcomes in childhood onset nephrotic syndrome.
3. Describe new treatment approaches for childhood onset nephrotic syndrome.

**Intended audience:** This activity is specifically directed towards the pediatrician, but it is open to all other interested physicians, residents, medical students, and allied health professionals.
