Brett King, DDS, attended Tulane University for his undergraduate education where he studied history and architecture. Following university, he spent a year in Japan teaching English. Dr. King graduated from Northwestern University Dental School in Chicago, Illinois and completed a residency in oral and maxillofacial surgery at Loma Linda University Medical Center in California and a residency in dental anesthesiology at Mt. Sinai Hospital and School of Medicine in New York City.

Dr. King practiced in New York City for 10 years before returning to New Orleans in 2014. Prior to joining Children's Hospital full-time, Dr. King was an Associate Professor at LSU Health Sciences Center in New Orleans, where he maintains an academic appointment in the Department of Surgery. Dr. King is the Service Line Chief for the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery.
