

Carrie Henderson, MD, is Professor of Pediatrics in the Division of Critical Care Medicine at Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center. Dr. Henderson earned her medical degree from the University of Kentucky College of Medicine and completed her Pediatrics residency at Vanderbilt University. She furthered her training with a fellowship in Pediatric Critical Care at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center as well as a fellowship in Clinical Medical Ethics at the MacLean Center for Clinical Medical Ethics at the University of Chicago. Before arriving in New Orleans in 2023, Dr. Henderson served as Professor of Pediatrics at Children's of Mississippi and Core Faculty in the Center for Bioethics and Medical Humanities at the University of Mississippi Medical
