



She completed her residency and fellowship training at UAB as well. In October 2022, Dr. Simpson joined the faculty at Tulane University as Professor of Pediatrics, Section Chief of Adolescent Medicine, and the Chief Clinical Diversity Officer for the School of Medicine.
