



Neal Jackson, MD, a Louisiana native, is Fellowship-trained and Board-Certified in Neurotology, the subspecialty dealing with hearing and balance disorders. After earning a Medical Doctorate (MD) degree from the University of Texas Health Science Center in San Antonio, Dr. Jackson then completed a

5-year residency training in Otolaryngology at LSU Health Science Center-New Orleans. He then completed a 2-year Fellowship in Neurotology, Otology, and Skull Base Surgery at the Michigan Ear Institute, the largest neurotology practice in the country.

Dr. Jackson was recruited to Tulane University in 2018 and in 2019 joined the staff of Children's Hospital New Orleans. Dr. Jackson started the Cochlear Implant Programs at Tulane University Medical Center in 2019 and at the Southeast Veterans Health Care System in 2020. As a skull base surgeon, he frequently works with neurosurgeons for the evaluation and management of skull base tumors and infections. Dr. Jackson has an active role in educating medical students and residents about care of the ear.

Objectives: At the conclusion of this activity, participants should be able to:

- Describe pertinent anatomy of the ear with otoscopy.
- Understand the mechanics of a cochlear implant, and therefore who may benefit.
- Appreciate the commitment a patient makes to the surgical and healing process when opting for a cochlear implant.

Intended audience: This activity is specifically directed towards the pediatrician, but it is open to all other interested physicians, residents, medical students, and allied health professionals.
