Maradith Skalak, MD, is Assistant Professor of Pediatrics in the Division of Neonatology at Tulane University School of Medicine. She earned her medical degree at The Ohio State University College of Medicine and completed her Residency in Pediatrics at St. John Children's Hospital in Detroit, Michigan. Following a year serving as Chief Resident, Dr. Skalak furthered her training with a Fellowship in Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center. She joined the Tulane faculty in 2021. Dr. Skalak also serves as Associate Program Director for the Tulane Pediatrics Residency Program.

Dr. Skalak will be joined by guest speaker Lacey Ponder.

- Assess the ethical dimensions of providing intensive medical and surgical care to infants with Trisomy 13 and 18.
- Examine how anti-disability bias shapes physician attitudes towards providing care for infants with chromosomal anomalies.
- Recognize the impact of language and terminology


