Dr. Chowdry is an associate professor of clinical medicine in hematology/oncology. She specializes in genitourinary malignancies. Her research interests include identifying causes of cancer disparities, racial/ethnic variables in cancer care, and cancer prevention.

Recognizing that many patients are traveling great distances for cancer care and clinical trials opportunities, Dr. Chowdry started an oncology clinic at Lallie Kemp Regional Medical Center, a rural hospital located in Independence, Louisiana. Currently, the clinic provides standard of care cancer therapies with the goal of offering clinical oncology trials.

In 2024, Dr. Chowdry's work was recognized by the American Cancer Society's Cure by Design as a Cure Champion Honoree.
