

Dr. Lamichhane's Ph.D. research was focused on microRNAs and their regulatory roles in human colorectal cancer cells.

Dr. Lamichhane joined the Department of Genetics, School of Medicine, LSU Health Sciences Center, in February 2022 as a first Postdoctoral Fellow in Dr. Yaguang Xi's research group, where he investigated the role of KIFC1 gene in cancer progression, metastasis, and drug resistance.

Dr. Lamichhane joined Dr. Hari K. Koul's research group in August 2023 as a second Postdoctoral Fellow, where he is investigating the functional role of SPDEF in tumor progression and its response to an AR-pathway inhibitor (Enzalutamide) in prostate cancer. Dr. Lamichhane's long-term goal is to understand gene function and develop gene-specific cancer treatments.
