Dr. Huang is an Associate Professor, Department of Pathobiological Sciences, School of Veterinary Medicine, Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge, LA. Her research is focused on lymphocyte development and function during infections. Researchers in her lab aim to exploit the properties of pathogenic/tumor antigen epitopes and host responses to antigens for disease prevention, diagnosis, and therapeutics.
