

Course Evaluation Committee

The charge to the Course Evaluation Committee is the evaluation of the courses and clerkships in the medical education program. This committee has the authority to initiate evaluations of courses and clerkships on a rotating basis and to present the results of those evaluations to the Curriculum Steering and Renewal Committees for the purposes of monitoring and initiating any necessary improvements. The committee interacts closely with the student-run Aesculapian Society and meets approximately four times per year.

The committee is comprised of faculty members from basic science and clinical departments and up to 6 student representatives from the 2nd, 3rd, or 4th year classes. Committee members are required to participate in course and clerkship reviews periodically. The Associate Dean for Undergraduate Medical Education serves in an ex-officio, non-voting capacity.
