

### **Curriculum Steering Committee**

The primary responsibility is comprehensive oversight and management of the medical school educational program, ensuring that the curriculum is sufficiently integrated and meeting the educational program objectives (EPOs). This committee ensures ongoing attention to and compliance with LCME elements related to the curriculum by continuously monitoring educational program components per the CQI process timeline. It has the authority to approve curriculum policies and major curriculum changes and presents its actions and approvals to the Dean, Administrative Council, and Faculty Assembly. It recommends directions for the Curriculum Renewal and other committees regarding potential curriculum revisions and assessment methods. The committee meets 3-4 times per year (more frequently as needed).
