

Student Promotions Committee (Junior and Senior)

The Student Promotions Committee (L3 and L4) considers academic problems of students enrolled in the clerkship portion of the curriculum using the guidelines established by the committee on Academic Standards. The committee discusses individual students in academic difficulty at length, and hears the perspective of clerkship directors, general faculty, and sometimes the student him or herself. The committee makes recommendations regarding promotion or remediation and forwards those recommendations to the dean for approval. The committee consists of the some clerkship directors and representatives of the general faculty plus representatives of the Dean's Office who are non-voting members. The Associate Dean for Student Affairs and Records provides logistical support, the list of students under consideration, and the records of each student to be discussed for all promotions committee meetings.
