

Course Evaluation Committee

The charge to the Course Evaluation Committee is evaluation of the individual courses and clerkships in the medical education program. This committee reviews summative student evaluations of the courses and clerkships by the Aesculapian Society. It has the authority to initiate evaluations of courses and clerkships on a rotating basis and presents its findings to the Curriculum Steering and Renewal Committees.

The committee is comprised of faculty members from basic science and clinical departments and up to 6 student representatives from the 2nd, 3rd, or 4th year classes. Committee members are required to participate in course and clerkship reviews periodically. The Associate Dean for Undergraduate Medical Education serves in an ex-officio, non-voting capacity.
