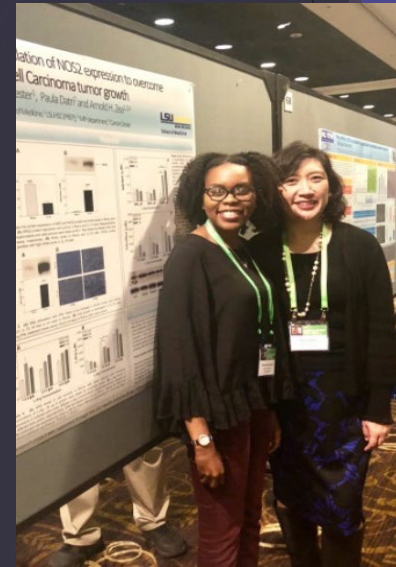
- ▶ The presentation will be linked on your website next to your abstract and poster.

Following the research many students:

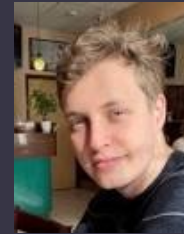
- ▶ Maintain contact with mentors, laboratory personnel, and other interns

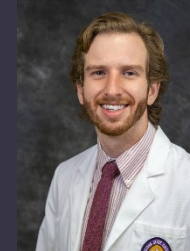

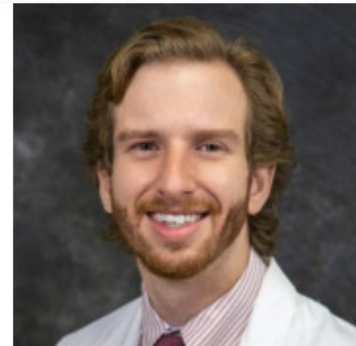

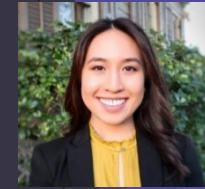
