Center for Advanced Learning & Simulation, Center for Advanced Practice, Student Learning Center, and NSTC

Improving students critical thinking skills through active learning and hands-on skills training using cadavers & simulation. Over 13,200 students annually. The Learning Centers are a total of 105,651 sq/ft. educational space.



School of Medicine students 800 annually. Active learning using simulation-based training, task trainers, and cadavers.

ACGME – 779 Residents and 118 Fellows annually. Complex simulation and cadaveric training



Nursing Simulation and Training Center (NSTC) is 28,800 sq/ft. Over 900 students annually. ICU/OR simulation rooms with high fidelity patient simulators and a 20 bed hospital ward.
