#### Welcome, Dr. Kirk Thame

The Department of Pediatrics welcomes Dr. Kirk Thame as Associate Professor of Clinical Pediatrics and Division Head of Pediatric Gastroenterology. Dr. Thame received his medical degree from the University of the West Indies in Kingston, Jamaica in 1992 and an Advanced Diploma in Child Health in 1995 from the same institution. He completed his Pediatric Residency at Jackson Memorial Hospital and the University of Miami followed by a Pediatric Gastroenterology Fellowship at St. Louis Children's Hospital and Washington University. After training, Dr. Thame returned to Jamaica to establish the



country and region's first pediatric gastroenterology service. He moved on to the University of Alabama at Birmingham in 2008 and then Vanderbilt University in 2014. At both universities, he created and fostered new services, including multidisciplinary clinics within Pediatric GI and established the first pediatric intestinal motility program at Vanderbilt. Here at LSU Pediatrics, Dr. Thame will also serve in the roles of Vice Chair of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion as well as the Service Line Chief and Senior Diversity Officer at Children's Hospital. 

## Pennington / Louisiana NORC - 2024 P&F RFA

The Pennington/Louisiana NORC is pleased to announce a Pilot and Feasibility

Grant Program. The full text of the Application Instructions can be found here.

The major objective of this program is to provide research support to early-stage scientists and multidisciplinary teams to develop preliminary data and/or novel methods involving nutrition and/or obesity-related research.

The highest priority will be given to translational research projects related to nutrition and/or obesity throughout the lifespan. The P&F awards are intended to generate preliminary data for the investigator to obtain extramural research funding from the NIH (e.g., K01, R01).

- Funding available: \$100,000
