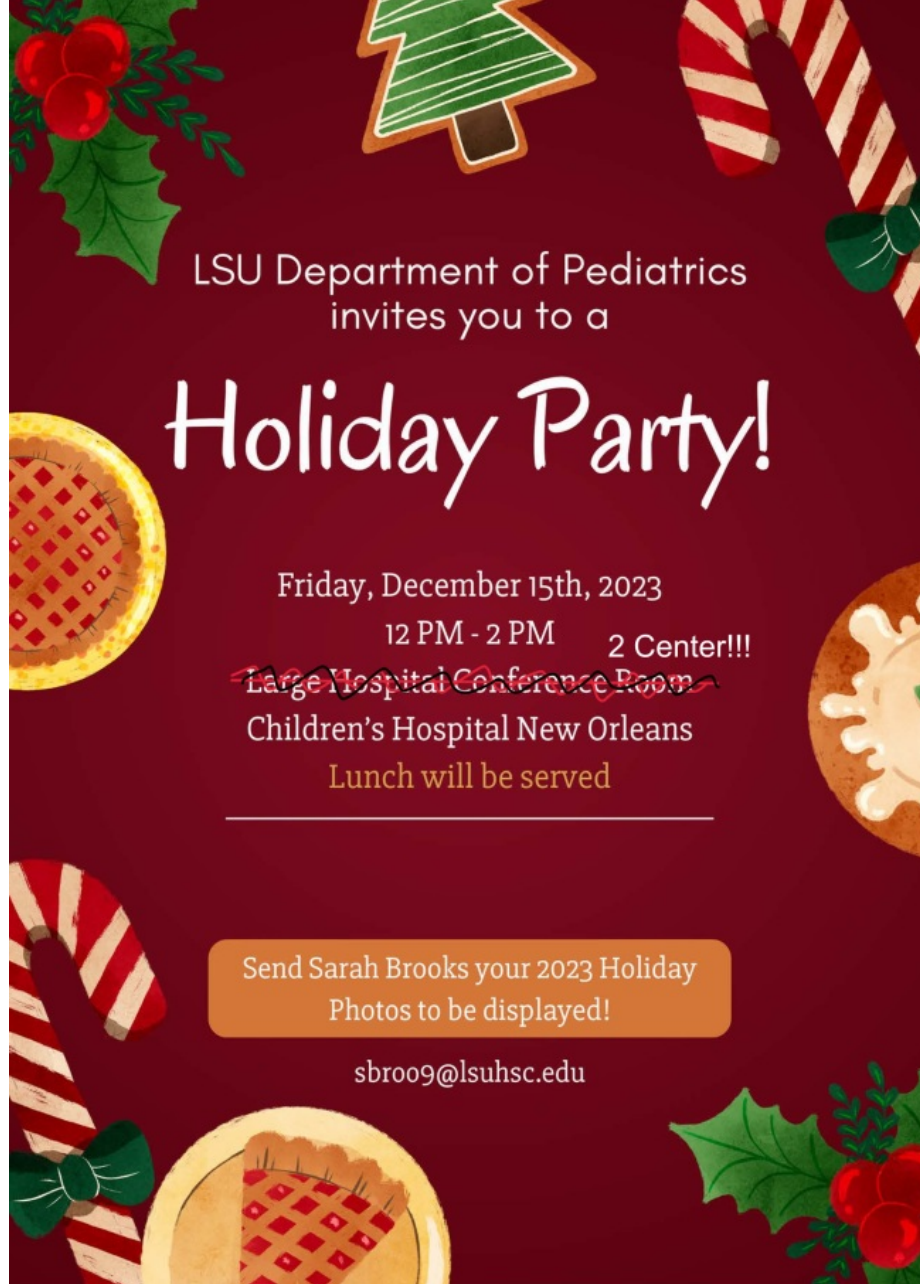

Tiffany Munzer, MD, is Clinical Assistant Professor at University of Michigan Health at C.S. Mott Children's Hospital in Ann Arbor, Michigan. She earned her medical degree from the University of Arizona College of Medicine and completed her Pediatrics residency at the University of Michigan. Dr. Munzer furthered her training with a fellowship in Developmental Behavioral Pediatrics, also at the University of Michigan. Her clinical focus includes providing care for children with autism, ADHD, learning disabilities and other developmental concerns. Her research focuses on how different forms of media (books, digital devices) might affect how young children and parents engage. Dr. Munzer serves on the Executive Committee of the AAP's Council on Communications and Media (COCM).

Objectives: At the conclusion of this activity, participants should be able to:

1. Understand how to assess social media use, and problematic behavior, and incorporate screen guidance into the Well Child Visit
2. Be able to provide parents with guidance regarding child and adolescent social media and screen use
