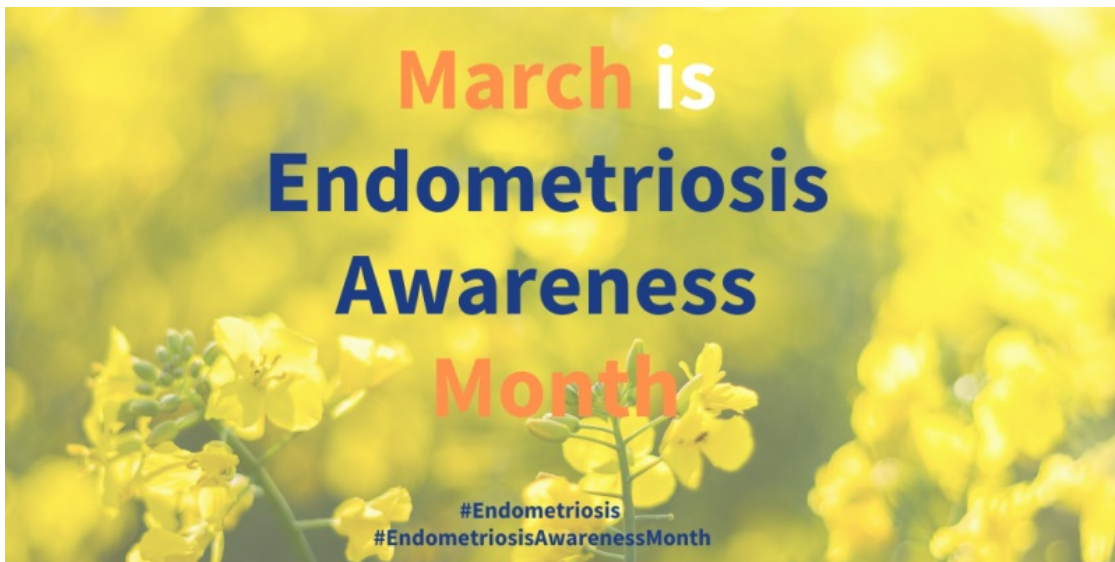
Schwartz Rounds are a multidisciplinary forum where CHNOLA team members

Dr. Gillon earned his medical degree from Penn State College of Medicine and then began his pediatrics training with residency at Johns Hopkins Hospital. He furthered his training with a Pediatric Emergency Medicine Fellowship at Dell Medical School at UT Austin and an Advanced Emergency Medicine Ultrasonography Fellowship at Emory University School of Medicine. Dr. Gillon joined the medical staff at CHNOLA in 2021.

Emily Masoumy, MD, FAAP is a board-certified Neonatal-Perinatal medicine physician and an Assistant Professor of Pediatrics in the Department of Pediatrics at LSU Health Sciences Center. Dr. Masoumy earned her medical degree from the Medical College of Georgia in Augusta, then continued her education in Pediatrics Residency at Children's Hospital of Georgia in Atlanta.
