Leron Finger, MD, is the Chief Quality Officer at Children's Hospital New Orleans. Dr. Finger earned his medical degree from the LSU School of Medicine in New Orleans. He completed his pediatrics internship and residency at Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital in Cleveland, Ohio. He then furthered his training with a fellowship in pediatric critical care, also at Rainbow Babies and Children's.

Dr. Finger is board-certified in Pediatrics and Pediatric Critical Care Medicine and serves as Clinical Assistant Professor of Pediatrics, LSU Health New Orleans. In October of 2021, Dr. Finger also took on the role of Associate Chief Medical Officer. In this capacity, Dr. Finger works in collaboration with CMO, Dr. Mark Kline and oversees medical informatics across the organization.

1. Understand the organizational methodology of the pediatric safety collaborative Solutions for Patient Safety (SPS).
2. Describe the improvement approach for a specific hospital acquired condition, Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infection (CLABSI).
3. Explain the SPS framework for addressing safety disparities.
