Things to Keep in Mind Certifications

Certifications are always a great way to show your knowledge in a certain topic area.

Research Administrators Certification Council: https://www.cra-cert.org/

Three offerings: Certified Research Administrator (CRA), Certified Pre-Award Research Administrator (CPRA), and Certified Financial Research Administrator (CFRA)

Committed to the continuing improvement of the research administration profession and to assisting in the education and training of individuals who wish to become proficient in the research administration field

The CRA shows a general knowledge of the Research Administration field while the CPRA and CFRA are more specific.

Provides both Body of Knowledge sessions and online practice sessions for a fee; Current exam fees are \$395 per exam

Things to Keep in Mind Certification

Certified Grants Management Specialist through the National Grants

Management Association:

Demonstrated knowledge of the professional domains that encompass the tasks and knowledge required of a grants management professional in various practice settings

Standalone credential and do not need to be a member of the National Grants Management Association to sit for the exam

Offers a Body of Knowledge session for a fee (\$849 Early Bird/\$899 Standard for Members and \$1,023 Early Bird/\$1,073 Standard for Non-Members) and a practice test <u>free</u> for one time after registering and paying exam fee

Current testing fee is \$500 for members and \$674 for non-members

Certified Clinical Research Professional through the Society for Clinical Research Administrators:

Creates an internationally accepted standard of knowledge, education, and experience by which clinical research professionals will be recognized by the clinical research community

Standalone credential and do not need to be a member of the Society for Clinical Research Administrators to sit for the exam

Has a Resource Manual specific to the exam for purchase for \$50; Website lists a number of suggested resources for preparing for the exam

Current testing fee is \$395 for members and \$450 for non-members

Things to Keep in Mind Certification

Association for Clinical Research Professionals: https://www.acrpnet.org/certification/

Recognizes clinical research professionals of all types, regardless of their roles or functional activities on the clinical study team

Multiple credentials that include: ACRP Certified Professional, Certified Clinical Research Associate, Certified Clinical Research Coordinator, Certified Principal Investigator, ACRP Medical Device Professional, and ACRP Project Manager

Offers a variety of training packages to help assess your current knowledge and provides a practice assessment to a comprehensive training program for your chosen credential (Prices vary depending on your choice of package)

Current testing fee for the ACRP Certified Professional is \$435 Early Bird/\$485 Standard for members and \$460 Early Bird/\$600 Standard for non-members
