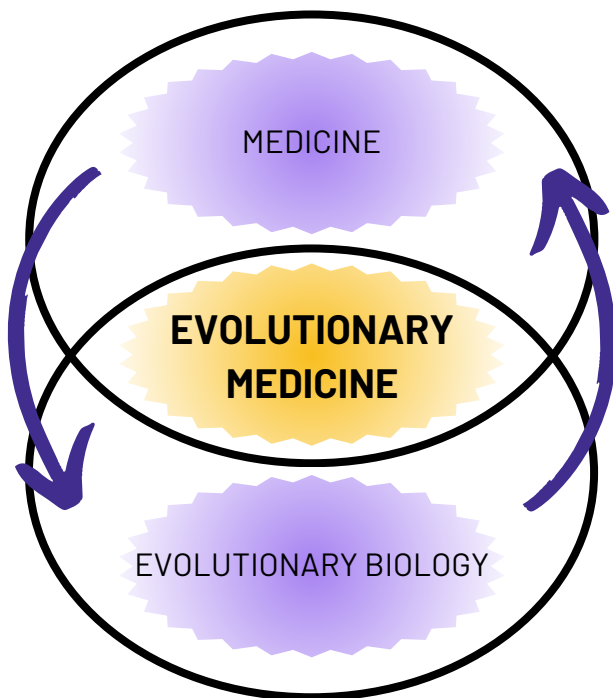


EVOLUTIONARY APPROACHES TO MEDICINE
