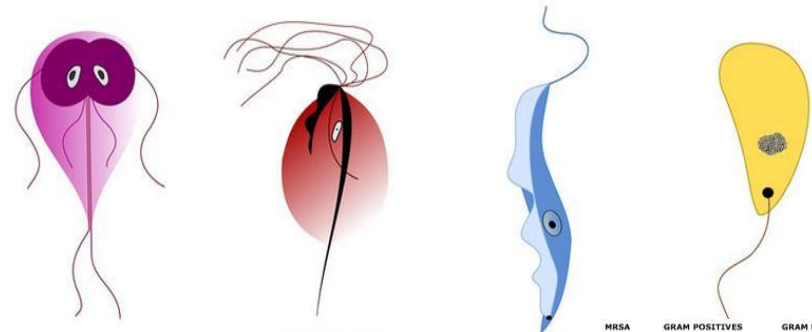

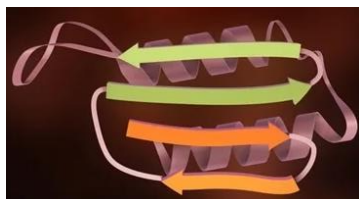

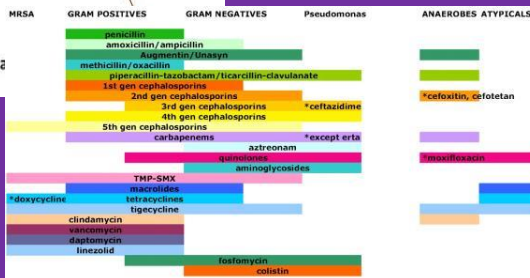
Giardia intestinalis
