

Health Professions Scholarship Program



What is it?

A post undergraduate scholarship available to qualifying students who wish to earn professional degrees from accredited medical, dental, optometry, veterinary, psychiatric nurse practitioner, clinical or counseling psychology programs. Obligation is to serve a set amount of time as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Army at the completion of school, residency, or board certification exams.

Basic Qualifications

Each HPSP category will have its own set of qualifications. The following requirements apply to all applicants.

- US Citizen
- Medically fit to serve as a commissioned officer
- Able to acquire a security clearance

Service Obligation

Medical

- Year for year the length of the received scholarship or residency program, whichever is longer.
- 4 year minimum if bonus is accepted

Dental

- Year for year of scholarship received
- 4 year minimum if bonus is accepted
- 3 year minimum regardless of length of scholarship

Veterinary

- ½ year for each ½ year of scholarship received
- 3 year minimum

Nurse

- 3 years

Optometry and Clinical Psychology

- ½ year for each ½ year of scholarship received
- 2 year minimum

Categories

Medical (1-4 years)

- Pays for tuition, fees, and supplies
- \$20,000 bonus
- \$2,728 monthly stipend
- 99% residency match rate

Dental (2-4 years)

- Pays for tuition, fees, and supplies
- \$20,000 bonus
- \$2,728 monthly stipend
- Advanced education opportunities

Veterinary (3 years)

- Pays for tuition, fees, and supplies
- \$2,728 monthly stipend
- Attend advanced education course

Doctor of Nursing Practice

- Pays for tuition, fees, and supplies
- \$2,728 monthly stipend
- CRNA
- Family Nurse Practitioner
- Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner
- Midwife Nurse Practitioner

Optometry (1-3 years)

Clinical Psychology (1-2 years)

- Pays for tuition, fees, and supplies
- \$2,728 monthly stipend
