TEACHING EXPERIENCE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

My practice includes 40% effort working with residents and medical students at the LSU Health Baton Rouge Perkins Surgery Center. This is an outpatient facility where we take care of the Our Lady of the Lake (LOL) Acute Care Surgery patients once they are discharged from main campus, as well as new patients with surgical issues. At Perkins, I work with LSU medical students, PA students, LSU interns, third year residents and occasionally the chief residents. We coordinate ongoing care, as well as perform outpatient surgeries at Perkins. We discuss patient selection and appropriate preoperative work-up and risk stratification. If a patient is not a candidate for Perkins outpatient center, I help coordinate care with the appropriate surgeon at LOL.

Working in this capacity allows me to participate in the education of trainees significantly. I am frequently recognized for being a top EPA evaluator. I complete monthly Innovations evaluation of the residents working with me. I assist with the skills portion of Intern Boot Camp annually. I also assist in the Perkins suturing workshops for medical students several times a year. I participate in Surgery applicant interviews and attend the surgery applicant Meet and Greets. I regularly attend LSU New Orleans didactics on Thursday morning via zoom (as I am contracted to be on-site at St. James Parish Hospital on Thursdays) and attend in-person didactics on Monday afternoons at Our Lady of the Lake in Baton Rouge. I participate the Cohn Rives Conference and Research Day annually. I also attend general surgery journal club when scheduling permits.

I joined LSU in March of 2019. I was initially hired to work in the LSU Healthcare Network, then transitioned to the School of Medicine in 2023.

- 2026 – present Medical Executive Committee member, St. James Parish Hospital. The MEC is the primary liaison between the medical staff at St. James Parish Hospital and the Board of Trustees. We oversee the conduct of physicians, patient safety and quality of care. We work to develop and enforce policies and grant privileges.

Clinical Service:

My practice is 40% effort working with LSU general surgery residents and medical students at the LSU Health Baton Rouge Perkins Surgery Center (as noted in the teaching portion of this document) and 60% effort working as a solo practitioner at St. James Parish Hospital, a critical access hospital. Between the two locations, I routinely work a minimum of forty hours per week, not including call and after-hours consults. We usually treat 30-40 patients at the Perkins general surgery clinic on Mondays in Baton Rouge. I usually perform 3-5 surgeries at the Perkins outpatient surgery center on Tuesdays with the residents and students.

My clinic service at St. James Parish Hospital does not include teaching medical students or residents currently due to ACGME logistics, but it does provide an extremely valuable service to this community that struggles with access to surgical care otherwise. As the only surgeon for the majority of three parishes, I see a wide range of maladies requiring surgical intervention. I personally coordinate the majority of the work-up which can usually be performed on site. In the occasional event that a patient does not meet criteria for safe surgery at this critical access hospital, then I will coordinate referrals to one of my colleagues at a facility with more resources. Wednesday clinic at St. James usually books 12 patients, plus add-ons and prn consults. Most of the clinic encounters are new patients which typically require review of outside imaging and reports, as well as multidisciplinary care coordination. Thursdays and Fridays are a combination of clinic and surgery which would include approximately 10 clinic patients and 3-7 OR procedures.

In-patient service activities:

2023 – present	I cover emergency room and inpatient floor consults onsite at St. James Parish Hospital on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.
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Clinic coverage:

2023 – present	I work in Baton Rouge with the surgery residents at Perkins Surgery Clinic on Mondays and Tuesdays. Office visits are conducted on Mondays and outpatient surgeries are conducted on Tuesdays. I staff the surgery clinic at St. James Parish Hospital on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. My operating room days there include some Thursdays and most Fridays at St. James Parish Hospital. I am the only practicing general surgeon in all of St. James Parish and St. John the Baptist Parish. This position fulfills a significant need for timely access to surgical care in these communities.
